

Experience the 2025 Jubilee Year in Rome—a holy year of grace occurring only every quarter century. Thousands of pilgrims celebrate throughout the year during which the Catholic Church offers the faithful the possibility of obtaining plenary indulgence. The Holy Year begins with the rite of the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica by the Pope, followed by the opening of Holy Doors of the other Papal basilicas—St. John Lateran, St. Paul Outside the Walls, and St. Mary Major—made accessible to visitors throughout this special and inspirational year.

ROME Visit all 4 major basilicas—St Peters, St. John Lateran, St Paul outside the Walls, and St Mary Major, as well as the Basilica of St. Lawrence Outside the Walls, the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem and the Basilica of St. Sebastian Outside the Walls. All these holy places make up the Seven Churches Pilgrimage, originally conceived by St. Philip Negri in the 16th century. A Local Guide will also take you to discover the Catacombs, former underground burial grounds that date from the second to the fifth century, principally used by Christians and Jews. The Papal audience and the Sunday Angelus prayer in Vatican City's St. Peter Square are also part of the experience (if available), along with time for prayer at the Holy Stairs and a visit to Castel Gandolfo, the summer Papal residence featuring beautifully designed gardens. Masses will be available during the tour itinerary. A visit to Rome during the Holy Year is an experience not to be missed, a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation.
